The Forty Hours Devotion is a continuous prayer made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn exposition. In the Bible the number 40 is associated with a sacred period of time: the rain at the time of the flood of Noah lasted 40 days and nights, and the Israelites wandered in the desert for 40 years on the way to the Promised Land. Jesus fasted for 40 days before beginning his public ministry. The devotion was promoted by both Saint Philip Neri and Saint Ignatius of Loyola in the 1500s. In the USA, Saint John Neumann (1811-1860), bishop of Philadelphia, helped to spread the devotion.

Although the Mass is central to Catholic life, devotions to the Eucharist are also important. Through them we can adore Jesus, pray in his presence, express our sorrow for sin, and experience a oneness with him that leads us to participate in the Mass. Because the Holy Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" ("LG," No. 11).

There are three special dimensions surrounded with this devotion: the protection from evil and temptation; reparation for our own sins and for the souls in purgatory; and deliverance from political, material or spiritual disasters. Here the faithful implore our Lord to pour forth His abundant graces not only for themselves, but their neighbours, not only for their own personal needs, but for those of the world.

The Forty Hours Devotion provides a wonderful opportunity for the spiritual growth of each person and the parish as a whole. In a world where temptation and evil abound, where devotion to the Mass and our Lord in the Holy Eucharist have declined, where the practice of penance and confession have been forgotten, we need the Forty Hours Devotion more than ever.
